Considered and resolved to recommend to the Senate for approval the recommendations, dated April 16, 1968 (Appendix XXV) of the Special Standing Committee for Correspondence Courses, with regard to some modification in the scheme, duration of courses, rates of tuition fees and other allied matters.

35. Considered and resolved to recommend to the Senate for approval the schedule of fees to be charged from the students to be admitted to various Correspondence Courses XXVI).

36. Considered and resolved to approve the recommendations of the High-Powered Committee, appointed under Ordinance 5 relating to Internal Assessment (Revised), that Shri Anupinder Singh, a candidate for M.A. (Economics) Part II examination, April 1968, be given 3 grace marks in Internal Assessment so as to enable him to appear in the examination.

37. Considered and resolved to recommend to the Senate for approval the recommendation of the Vice-Chancellor that, with effect from 18.4.1968, the services of the following officials working in the various departments of the University be placed at the disposal of the Languages Department of the State Government located at Chandigarh, for teaching Punjabi to Govt. officials and that these incumbents be paid an extra allowance of Rs100/-p.m. each during the period they work at Chandigarh:

Proceedings of the meeting of the Special Standing Committee for the correspondence course, held on Tuesday, April 16, 1963, at 3.30 p.m. in the office of the Registrar, Punjab University, Patiala.

1. It was decided that duration of the following courses (through correspondence be the same as in the case of regular students:

Pre-University	one year
B.A.	three years

2. It was decided that the tuition fee be charged from the students residing in India and abroad, as given below:

The first instalment of the fee will be paid at the time of admission. The dates on which payments are to be made for the

subsequent instalments will be notified to the students after admission.

(A student is required to come to Patiala for taking the examinations unless the University authorities decide to hold the examination/s at some other place.)

Note: This shall not apply to students living abroad.

Admission to all the courses be open to persons living in India and abroad.

4. It was decided that a Committee consisting of the following be appointed for each subject of study to recommend names of persons to be appointed as lesson writers:-

1. The Head of University Department in the subject concerned.

(In the case of Political Science and Civics, the Head will be the Head of History, and in the case of Hindi, the Head will be Head of Sanskrit Deptt.)

2. Senior-most teacher in the subject concerned in the Directorate of Correspondence Courses;

3. Three teachers in the subject to be recommended by the Vice-Chancellor.

5. It was decided that teachers working in the Directorate of Correspondence Courses, if called upon to write lessons, will not be paid any remuneration for the same. In case of Preliminary Examination/Punjabi this work will be normally done by the Staff of the Correspondence Courses.

6. It was decided that the Assistant Directors be asked to divide the course of study of their respective subjects, of each year, into about 25 to 30 lessons, within a week, and to write first lesson of the subject of each course by May 15, 1968, and these lessons be got approved by the Head of the University Department in the subject concerned.

\*The Syndicate may impose restriction in case of certain categories, if need be.

7. It was decided that the first lesson in each course should be mailed out to students by August 1, 1968.

8. Resolved that:-

- (i) the last date for receipt of application forms for admission be fixed as July 15, 1968, and with a late-fee of ₹ 5/- as July 31, 1968;
- (ii) the price of the prospectus for those living abroad be fixed at \$ 1/ Sh.8;
- (iii) the office be directed to prepare immediately a brief leaflet giving information about the duration of courses, corresponding fees etc., and this leaflet be supplied to persons free of cost.
